Pursuant to the declared policy of the State to ensure the quality, reliability, security and affordability of the supply of electric power, the Department of Energy (DOE) hereby enjoins the NGCP and DUs, as Administrators of the Interruptible Load Program (ILP),<sup>1</sup> to be fully ready to activate and implement the ILP during the summer/dry season which has recently commenced. This is in addition to other measures to mitigate the effects of the El Niño phenomenon in the power sector.

In this regard, the NGCP and DUs are requested to submit the following:

- 1. updates on the registered ILP participants; and
- 2. any concerns and request for support for DUs which are new to the implementation of the ILP.

NEA is also enjoined to provide the necessary assistance to the electric cooperatives (ECs) in the implementation of the ILP and the submission of the above information to the DOE.
