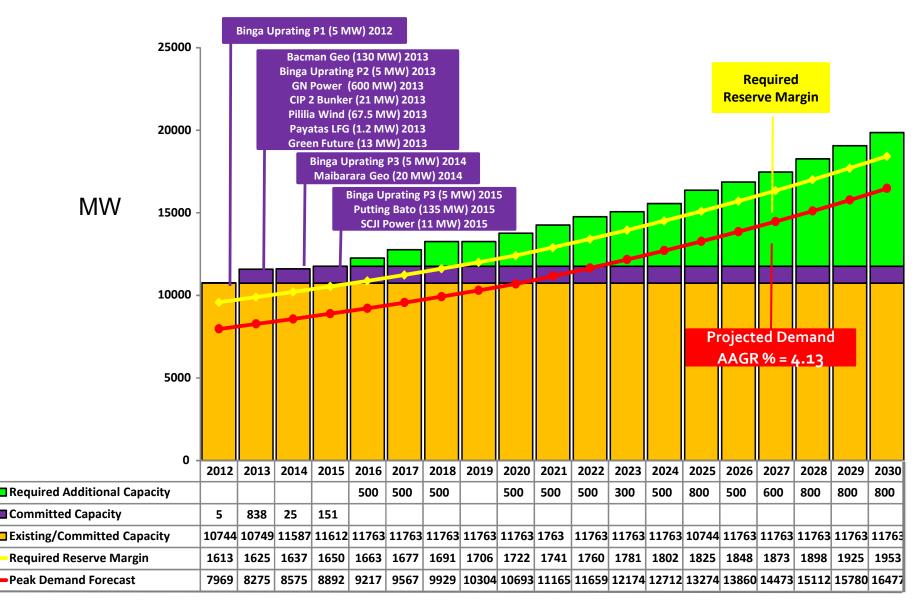

## Luzon Supply-Demand Outlook, 2012-2030

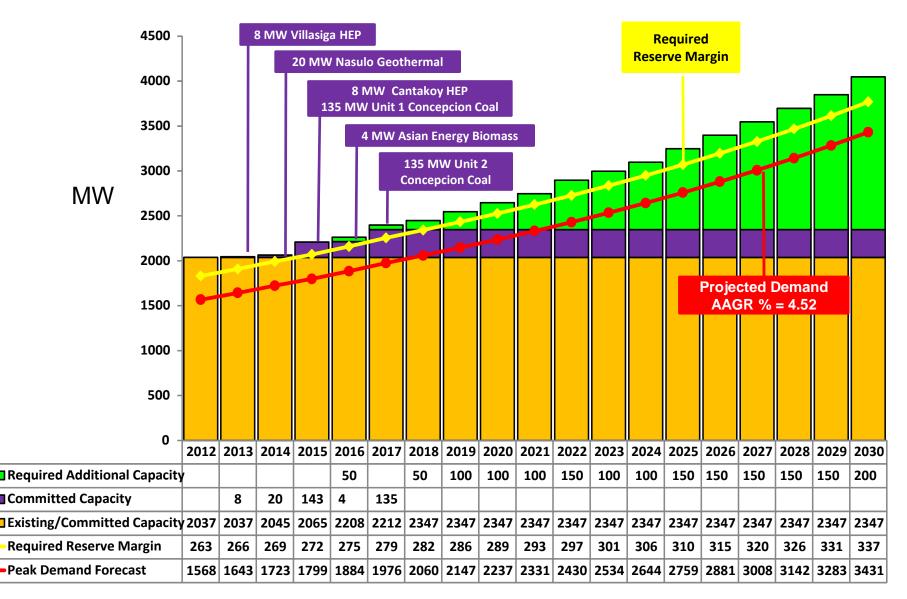
A total additional capacity of 8,100 MW is needed onwards to 2030



#### A new capacity at 500 MW is needed starting 2016 to meet the demand and required reserve

#### Visayas Supply-Demand Outlook, 2012-

A total additional capacity of 1,700 MW is needed onwards to 2030



#### A new capacity at 50 MW is needed starting 2016 to meet the demand and required reserve

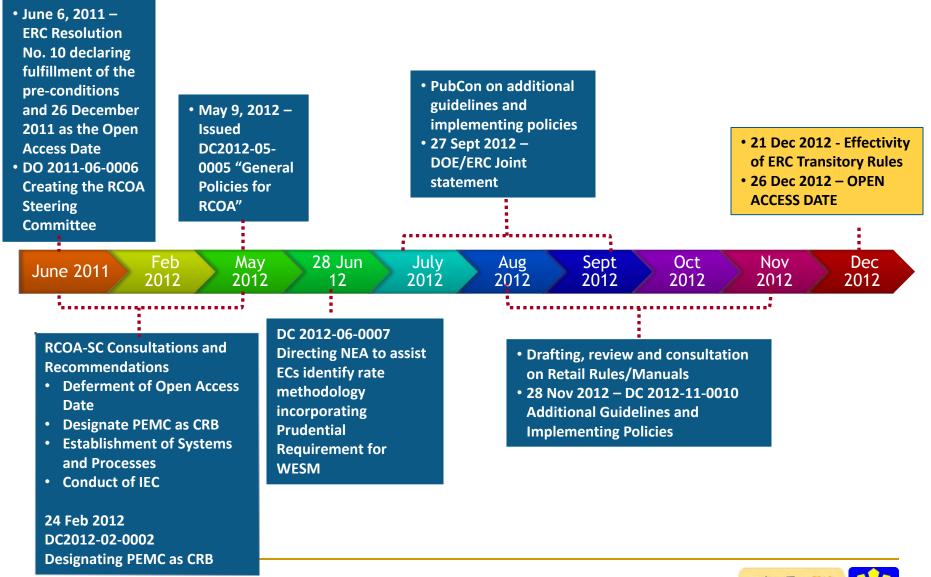


### **Recent Activities**
