



## INTER-AGENCY ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE (IAEECC)

RESOLUTION NO. 6, s. 2022

***Recommending to the Governance Commission for Government-Owned or -Controlled Corporations (GCG) to Consider, Include, and Adopt Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EEC) as One of the Criteria in the Performance Evaluation System for Government-Owned or -Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) in the Grant of Performance-Based Incentives***

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act (RA) No. 11285, or the Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EEC) Act, institutionalizes energy efficiency and conservation as a national way of life, enhances the efficient use of energy, and grants incentives to energy efficiency and conservation programs and projects;

**WHEREAS**, DOE Department Circular No. DC2019-11-0014, or the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA No. 11285 (EEC-IRR), provides the guidelines for the full implementation of the EEC Act and for the expansion of the Government Energy Management Program (GEMP) coverage to include all government entities, including departments, bureaus, offices, agencies, GOCCs, and their subsidiaries, self-governing boards or commissions, and other instrumentalities of the government, as well as state universities and colleges (SUCs), and political subdivisions of the local government units (LGUs);

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the EEC Act states that the DOE shall take the lead in the implementation of the law, and shall be responsible for the planning, formulation, development, implementation, enforcement, and monitoring of energy management policies and other related energy efficiency and conservation plans and programs;

**WHEREAS**, DOE Department Order (DO) No. DO2020-01-0001 organizes the Inter-Agency Energy Efficiency and Conservation Committee (IAEECC) and lays down its powers and

functions to primarily evaluate and approve government energy efficiency projects, and to provide strategic direction in the implementation of the GEMP;

**WHEREAS**, IAEECC Resolution No. 1, s. 2020 directs all government agencies to comply with the GEMP, orders the DOE to conduct energy audits, spot checks, technical analyses, and other research activities relative to energy efficiency projects of all government entities for the improvements of the GEMP;

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 25, s. 2011, was issued to rationalize, harmonize, streamline, simplify, integrate, and unify the efforts of government agencies mandated to exercise broad oversight of government agencies' performance;

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of RA No. 10149 created the GCG, which shall serve as the central advisory, monitoring, and oversight body with authority to formulate, implement, and coordinate policies on safeguarding the State's ownership rights and ensure that the operations of GOCCs are transparent and responsive to the needs of the public;

**WHEREAS**, Section 5(f) of RA No. 10149 mandated the GCG to establish the performance evaluation systems including performance scorecards which shall apply to GOCCs in general and to the various GOCC classification;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6(n) of RA No. 11285 provides that the GCG shall incorporate energy efficiency as a factor in evaluating the performance of GOCCs;

**WHEREAS**, EEC is considered as an integral solution to cushion the volatility of energy cost, achieve energy security, and assist in mitigating the threats of climate change;

**WHEREAS**, the recognition of EEC by the GCG will support the GOCCs' important role in the introduction and institutionalization of fundamental policies on EEC, including the promotion of efficient and judicious utilization of energy within their respective offices/facilities;

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of DOE DO No. DO2020-01-0001 provides that the IAEECC shall act as a collegial body, and approval of its actions may be made by a simple majority;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the members of the IAEECC:



**RESOLVED**, that EEC shall be considered, included, and adopted in the GOCCs' Performance Evaluation System to encourage them to comply with RA No. 11285 and the GEMP, as well as to foster EEC as a way of life;

**RESOLVED**, for this purpose, that the GCG shall include and adopt EEC criteria in evaluating the performance of GOCCs;

**RESOLVED**, that the EEC set of performance indicators shall be based on the GOCC's compliance to the EEC Act and EEC-IRR, GEMP, and all directives, advisories, issuances, as well as resolutions of the IAEECC;

**RESOLVED**, that the DOE, together with the GCG, shall develop and formulate the EEC set of performance indicators to be included as one of the criteria for the GOCCs' Performance Scorecard and/or Other Conditions and Requirements for the grant of the Performance-Based Incentive to its officers and employees;

**RESOLVED**, that said EEC set of performance indicators shall be approved by the IAEECC and shall be endorsed to the Office of the Chairman of the GCG for inclusion and adoption in the Performance Evaluation System for the GOCC Sector;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that this Resolution be approved and disseminated to all agencies concerned, principally to the GCG for proper implementation; and

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that this Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the Official Gazette or at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. A copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the University of the Philippines Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register.
